

# NutritionModels.com Licensing Guidance

## 1. Purpose

This document guides the selection of the appropriate NutritionModels.com software license based on the user's academic status and intended use. The appropriate license is determined by **who is using the software** and **how it will be used, not solely** by the source of funding.

## 2. General Licensing Principles

Academic, educational, and scholarly uses may qualify for Student or Limited licenses, depending on the user's status.

Commercial, consulting, contract, fee-for-service, extension-for-fee, private industry, or applied decision-support uses require a Flexible License, regardless of whether the work is performed by a university, government agency, company, nonprofit organization, or individual.

## 3. Student License

A Student License is available free of charge to eligible students who provide valid proof of active academic enrollment.

Eligible users include undergraduate, Master's, and Ph.D. students, as well as other formally enrolled students using the software for teaching, learning, coursework, thesis or dissertation research, academic training, or scholarly research.

The Student License is valid only while the student is actively enrolled. If a student graduates from one academic program but continues into another formal degree program, they may continue to qualify for a Student License after submitting updated proof of enrollment.

The Student License expires when the user is no longer an active student.

## 4. Limited License — Faculty, Educational, or Academic Use

A Limited License is appropriate for faculty, post-doctoral researchers, instructors, and university research personnel using the software for teaching, academic instruction, student training, academic research, thesis or dissertation supervision, and non-commercial scholarly research intended for publication.

This license is appropriate when the work is part of the academic mission of the university or educational institution and does not constitute consulting, contract research, fee-for-service work, extension-for-fee, private industry work, or commercial decision support.

## 5. Flexible License — Commercial, Consulting, or Contract Use

A Flexible License is required when the software is used for consulting, contract research, fee-for-service analysis, extension-for-fee activities, private industry work, commercial decision support, or applied work that benefits a client, company, producer group, agency, or other external entity as a service or deliverable.

This requirement applies regardless of whether the user is affiliated with a university, government agency, private company, nonprofit organization, or independent consulting entity.

The Flexible License also permits teaching, training, and educational use without restriction.

## 6. Practical examples

A student using the software for coursework, thesis, dissertation, or publishable academic research: **Student License**, with proof of active enrollment.

A student who graduates from one program and continues into another formal academic degree program: **Student License may continue**, after updated proof of active enrollment is submitted.

A faculty member using the software in a university course: **Limited License**.

A faculty member using the software for scholarly research intended for publication in a journal: **Limited License**, provided the work is not consulting, contract-service, fee-for-service, or commercial decision-support work.

A post-doctoral researcher using the software as part of a university research project intended for publication: **Limited License**.

A university research group using the software to provide analysis or recommendations as a paid service to producers, companies, agencies, or other external clients: **Flexible License**.

A government agency, university, company, or individual using the software to generate applied recommendations for operational, regulatory, business, or commercial decision-making: **Flexible License**, unless the use is strictly part of teaching, learning, or scholarly publication.

An industry-sponsored project where software outputs are used for product development, client service, consulting, or commercial decisions: **Flexible License**.

## 7. Misuse Policy

Use of a Student or Limited License for consulting, contract research, fee-for-service analysis, extension-for-fee, private industry work, or commercial decision support is not permitted. Such use may result in license termination, retroactive billing at the Flexible License rate, and loss of access to future registration or renewal.
